



Bully Proof Your School Evaluation & Analysis

This is a special service provided for schools to evaluate and analyze the bullying situation in their own community. All information collected will be treated with strict confidentiality and is only meant for use by the school governance initiating the evaluation. The service provided costs only **S\$4.00 per students**. For the evaluation and analysis to be accurate and appropriate for use, it will be beneficial to collect a **minimum of 1000 surveys in each exercise**. This exercise includes an hour Awareness Talk for participating students followed by the administration of the survey by the facilitators. Upon completion of evaluation and analysis, a report will be presented to the school governors uncovering the following:

- Population of students indicating that they have been bullied in the school
- Population of students indicating that they have not been bullied in the school
- Population of students who have encountered bullying and where it has happened
- Specific indication of where bullying has happened
- What the students think of bullying issues in the school

It is absolutely beneficial for the evaluation and analysis to be conducted prior to any intervention or prevention program which the school wishes to conduct. The outcome of the evaluation and analysis helps determine the current situation in the school. It shall also help to determine the necessary proactive solution that can be put in place to help students / staff / parents work cohesively towards a pro-social environment within the community. At the end of an active intervention or prevention program, a similar evaluation and analysis can again be conducted to find out if the bullying situation has improved.

Instruments Used

- The PRAQ (Peer Relation Assessment Questionnaire) which has been used in more than 7000 schools around the world.
- The DINO-Map which has been used with more than 4000 students in Singapore in year 2006.
